Frequently Asked Questions

What will we need to do when you are on Site.

In most cases we will require access to water and electric and toilet facilities and coffe where possible.

If we are going through your property.

If we are having to move through your property to access the garden, we will usually put down protective sheeting called corex, these will be taped together and left down for the whole build unless requested to take them up, please note that taking them up every night and putting them back down the next day will increase the time on site and increase the length of the build.

If you are having a new lawn laid.

If we are installing a new natural lawn and it is in the summer, the turf will need to be watered at least twice daily, in the morning and evening, if it is a really hot summer, it will need to be watered 3 time daily and in most cases cnnot b stood on for approx 4 to 6 weeks from being laid.

What will happen if it rains.

generally we will work through lights rain, however if it gets harder on the day we will let you kniw that we wont be able to work through.

What about really low temperatures.

Certain works that we do like paving and building walls etc, cannot be done if the temperature over night is below freezing, as the water content in the concrete mix can expand and destroy the works carried out, in these cases we will let you know and proceed when the temperature increases.


